The identification of the RSD priority communities was made following detailed bi-lateral discussions between the Australian and Queensland governments. These decisions were informed by the agreed National Principles for investments and sequencing of investments in remote locations which are contained in Schedules A and B of the Remote Service Delivery National Partnership Agreement (see http://www.federalfinancialrelations.gov.au/content/national_partnership_agreements/indigenous.aspx).
