Senator Boyce asked:

How many Local Implementation Plans (LIPs) currently contain Community Safety Plans which also address child safety issues? Do the plans for Fitzroy Crossing and Falls Creek have one? If not, why?

Answer:

20 finalised LIPs have an explicit commitment or alternative arrangement to develop community safety plans.

The LIPs for Fitzroy Crossing and Halls Creek do not include a commitment to develop community safety plans.

LIPs are community-owned documents that reflect community-identified priority issues and their local solutions.
