## Senator Sue Boyce asked:

What are you doing to make faster progress on the establishment of safe houses in the RSD priority communities?

## Answer:

Safe houses are already located in 15 of the 29 RSD priority communities across Australia. These are, by jurisdiction:

- New South Wales: Walgett, and Wilcannia
- Northern Territory: Angurugu, Gunbalanya, Lajamanu, Maningrida, Ngukurr, Ntaria (Hermannsburg), Wadeye, Wurrumiyanga (Nguiu), Yuendumu
- Queensland: Aurukun, Doomadgee, Hope Vale
- Western Australia: Halls Creek.

Other RSD communities which have identified a potential need for safe houses will take this forward as part of the implementation of their Local Implementation Plan.
