Senator Payne asked:

Could you provide me with the sites of the remaining 17 houses that are underway in Queensland and the ones that have been completed or refurbished.

Answer:

The Queensland Government advise that as at 30 June 2011, across the life of the National Partnership Agreement on Remote Indigenous Housing, 108 new houses have been completed and 577 houses have been refurbished. The locations of these are provided below.
