Senator Siewert asked:

Do you know how much money has been spent in individual priority sites since the commencement of the National Partnership on Remote Indigenous Services? For example, do you know how much the Australian and South Australian Governments have spent in Amata in the last three years?

Answer:

The amount of FaHCSIA program funding invested in the APY Lands during the 2011-12 financial year is approximately \$24 million, not including funding within the National Partnership Agreement on Remote Indigenous Housing (NPARIH).

Whilst final decisions are still being made, the amount of funding FaHCSIA expects to invest in the APY Lands during the 2012-13 financial year will be similar to that provided in 2011-12.

In 2011-12 NPARIH funding for SA overall was \$45.465 million.
