Senator Siewert asked:

How many houses in remote communities are under tenancy agreements? What is the breakdown per community?

Answer:

As reported under the NPARIH, 5,271 houses in remote communities had tenancy agreements in place as at 31 July 2012. The breakdown by jurisdiction is as follows:

Northern Territory – 2,903

Western Australia – 900

Queensland – 801

South Australia – 288

Tasmania – 59

New South Wales – 320

The request for tenancy agreement numbers per community should be directed to the Northern Territory and state governments.
