Question:

Has the department/agencies purchased any shredders in the last 12 months? If yes, provide details of how many shredders were purchased, the cost of each shredder, why each new shredder was needed and the purpose for which the shredder is to be used.

Answer:

The Department of Human Services has purchased 94 shredders since 1 July 2011, at an average cost per shredder of \$236.56 including GST. This represents a total cost of \$22,236.92 including GST.

Shredders are used to securely destroy documents which are no longer required to be retained by the department. The destruction of documents of this nature is undertaken in accordance with Section 24 of the *Archives Act 1983*, in accordance with normal administrative practice. Normal administrative practice allows staff to routinely destroy records that are not needed as evidence of an agency's business and that do not need to form part of its corporate records.
