The Marula project in Fitzroy Crossing is developing FAS diagnostic tools

a) How much federal funding has been provided?

b) When does the funding agreement end?

c) What has been allocated in future to continue the development of the diagnostic tools?

Answer:

- a) The Department of Health and Ageing and the Department of Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs are jointly contributing funding of \$1.8 million (GST incl.) up to June 2013, to the George Institute for Global Health to conduct Stage 2 of the Marulu: Lililwan Project.
- b) The funding agreement ends on 30 June 2013.
- c) No funding has been allocated to this project beyond June 2013. The George Institute for Global Health did not apply for further funding under the Flexible Funds arrangements.
