## **Ouestion:**

Please update if there have been any changes since Additional Estimates 2011-12 (February 2012) (E12-109):

Does the department/agency provide their Ministers and/or Parliamentary Secretaries and/or their offices with any electronic equipment? If yes, provide details of what is provided, the cost and to who it is provided.

#### Answer:

Yes. Each of the Ministers and the Parliamentary Secretary have the option to use a range of electronic equipment including a Blackberry, mobile broadband card, printer, laptop, and desktop computer. General office equipment such as multi-function devices, printers including secure Cabinet printers, televisions, DVD players, transcription kits, label makers and fax machines are allocated to each office for use by the Ministerial Office.

All equipment is provided in order for the Ministers and the Parliamentary Secretary, their staff, Departmental Liaison Officers and Graduates working in Ministers' and Parliamentary Secretary's offices to undertake portfolio related business. Previously purchased items returned to the Department of Health and Ageing are redeployed wherever possible within Ministerial and Parliamentary Secretary offices.
