Question:

What is the average hourly cost of doctors, psychologists and psychiatrists?

Answer:

The Australian Government is responsible for setting the Medicare Benefits Schedule (MBS) fees with rebates of 100 per cent of the MBS fee available for general practitioner consultations. For all other consultations covered under the MBS, the patient receives 85 per cent of the fee if the service is provided out-of-hospital, or 75 per cent of the fee if the service is provided in-hospital.

However, under section 51 (xxiiiA) of the Constitution, the Australian Government has no authority to control the amount health providers actually charge for their services. Health providers are free to determine the value of the health service they provide. This means that doctors, psychologists and psychiatrists are under no obligation to charge the MBS fee set by the Australian Government.

The MBS rebate for services provided by doctors, psychologists and psychiatrists is also determined by the amount of time each consultation takes. The following table outlines the MBS rebates for services provided by general practitioners, psychologists and psychiatrists under the Better Access to Psychiatrists, Psychologists, and General Practitioners under the Medicare Benefits Schedule initiative.
