Written Question on Notice

Senator Smith asked:

- a) In relation to the 18 new funds could you advise me of the quantum attached to each of those funds?
- b) Following on from that, can you advise how many funding applications were made for each of the 18 funds and how many of those were successful?

NOTE – this is an amended response to Estimates Question on Notice E12-410. A response to this Question on Notice was provided to the Committee on 8 August 2012. This amended response corrects the number of applications for the Substance Misuse Prevention and Service Improvement Grants Fund in the table at answer b) from 54 to 65. This was due to an administrative error. The total number of applications referred to in the introductory paragraph of part b) below, has also been corrected (previously 1565, now corrected to 1576).
