Senator Furner asked:

Can you compare how much aged pensions have increased under the Labor Government with how much they increased under the last 5 or 4.5 years of the Howard Government?

Answer:

Between November 2007 and May 2012 payments to age pensioners increased by \$204.49 a fortnight for single pensioners and \$227.50 a fortnight for pensioner couples combined.

Between April 2003 and November 2007 payments to age pensioners increased by \$102.05 a fortnight for single pensioners and \$167.84 a fortnight for pensioner couples combined.

Notes:

- 1. In April 2003, payments to age pensioners included the base pension, the GST Supplement, Pharmaceutical Allowance and Telephone Allowance.
- 2. In November 2007, payments to age pensioners included the base pension, the GST Supplement, Pharmaceutical Allowance, Telephone Allowance and Utilities Allowance.
- 3. In May 2012, payments to age pensioners included the base pension and the Pension Supplement, which contained the range of previous supplements and allowances listed in Note 2.
- 4. All amounts are expressed in nominal dollars.
