Senator Siewert asked:

When will FaHCSIA announce the exact locations of the 76 ATMs that are expected to provide free transactions by the end of this year?

Have the 76 ATM sites already been identified and, if so, how many are located in (a) South Australia, (b) Western Australia, (c) Queensland and (d) the Northern Territory?

Answer:

The communities to be covered by the ATM Reforms were negotiated between the Australian Bankers' Association, Treasury, the Reserve Bank of Australia, the banking industry and independent ATM operators.

FaHCSIA had no role in determining these locations.
