## Senator Fifield asked:

(a) As at the end of financial year 2011-2012, how many children are currently receiving funding under the Better Start Initiative?

(**b**) As at the end of financial year 2011-2012, how many applications have been received for funding under the Better Start Initiative?

(c) As at the end of the financial year 2011-2012, how many applications have been refused funding under the Better Start Initiative?

## Answer:

(a) As at 31 May 2012, 4,275 children were receiving funding under the Better Start Initiative (an additional 15 children have exited the initiative).

(**b**) 5,168 children applied for Better Start funding for the period 1 July 2011 to 31 May 2012.

(c) From 1 July 2011 to 31 May 2012 a total of 878 children were deemed ineligible for Better Start Funding.
