## **Question:**

There has been a recent outbreak of sniffing in a community north of Alice Springs, not far off the Stuart Highway this community stocks Opal fuel in its own store but is surrounded by Non-Opal outlets, a number of which are considered to be refusing to stock Opal fuel. Has the clock started ticking on these retail outlets? At which point will the powers of the LAF bill be used to force them to cease selling standard unleaded and then hopefully stock Opal.

## Answer:

In recent months, two sites on the Stuart Highway have agreed to voluntarily supply low aromatic fuel. Other sites in larger nearby regions are also being consulted about supplying low aromatic fuel.
