Question:

a) What are the terms of reference for the Expert Reference Group?

b) Who has been appointed to the Expert Reference Group?

- c) Will the re-design process include a public consultation period to gather input from mental health nurses, general practitioners, psychiatrists, consumers and carers who use the MHNIP?
- d) What is the planned timeframe for the MHNIP re-design process?

Answer:

- a) Terms of Reference for the Expert Reference Group (ERG): In the context of national mental health reform and other new and emerging programs, the ERG will provide confidential advice to the Department of Health and Ageing on:
 - ways to address the key findings of the Mental Health Nurse Incentive Programme (MHNIP) evaluation;
 - considerations for the re-design of the MHNIP; and
 - the future evaluation of the MHNIP.

The ERG may be asked to consider and provide advice on a range of matters relating to the MHNIP, including the development of a formal clinical governance framework and appropriate data collection protocols. Projects may also be commissioned to progress key aspects of the redesign work.

- c) A consultation process involving case studies, an online survey and a series of interviews with key stakeholders was conducted to inform the 2012 MHNIP Evaluation Report, which will inform the program redesign. Further consultation with key stakeholders will occur through the ERG. The need for any additional consultation with other stakeholders will be considered by the Department and the ERG as part of the redesign process.
- d) The MHNIP redesign process will be undertaken in the 2013-14 financial year.
