What is the average length of time it takes new high cost cancer treatments to get on to the PBS?

Answer:

The average time taken for Cabinet to consider high cost medicines (greater than \$10 million in any of the forward estimates years) following pricing agreement is currently around 4.2 months. For high cost medicines to treat cancer, the average time taken for Cabinet to consider following pricing agreement is currently around 5.8 months.
