Question:

- a) How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) this financial year to date?
- b) What are the department/agency's stationery costs for the financial year to date?

Answer:

- a) The Department of Health and Ageing provides stationery requirements to the Ministers and Parliamentary Secretaries in the Portfolio. The cost for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 May 2013 date is \$23,732 (GST exclusive).
- b) The cost for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 May 2013 date for stationery is \$933,767 (GST exclusive). This figure includes the Department, National Industrial Chemical Notification Assessment Scheme, Office of the Gene Technology Regulator and the Therapeutic Goods Administration and Australian and New Zealand Therapeutic Product Agency.
