Question:

- a) How many cars are owned by each department/agency?
- b) Where is the car/s located?
- c) What is the car/s used for?
- d) What is the cost of each car for this financial year to date?
- e) How far did each car travel this financial year to date?

Answer:

a) and b)

The Department of Health and Ageing and Portfolio Agencies own no cars except the Australian Radiation Protection Safety Agency (ARPANSA) which owns three.

- c) ARPANSA advised that their vehicles are used for emergency response and training – supporting their role in radiological and nuclear incidents.
- d) ARPANSA advised that the total cost for the three cars is \$13,351 for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 May 2013.
- e) ARPANSA advised that the three cars travelled 3177kms, 277kms and 24kms for the period 1 July 2012 to 31 May 2013.
