I would assume that the parameters of their funding agreements will indicate the amount of money that is going to that consortium. Is that the case?

- a) the total value of each funding agreement
- b) for which agreements is the Medicare Local the lead agency
- c) who the consortium members are

**Answer:**

The following table provides details of the lead agencies, consortium members and the total funding allocated to each of the 48 Medicare Local regions in contract under the Partners in Recovery (PIR) initiative.

Funding will be provided to the lead agency who will administer the funding in accordance with the agreed model for implementing PIR in the region, as set out in the funding agreement. Funding provided will need to cover all costs and expenses associated with the delivery of PIR in that region (i.e. employment of Support Facilitators and other staff, regional capacity building, maintaining partnerships and networks, operational costs, and the flexible funding pool).

Each funding agreement includes a list of consortium members who will oversee and manage implementation of the model in their region.
