Regarding recommendation 8 of the Inquiry, the Community Care and Population Health Principal Committee (a subcommittee of the Australian Health Ministers' Advisory Council) was to finalise the draft national framework for neonatal hearing screening for endorsement in early 2013.

- a) How come this has slipped from early 2013?
- b) When is it now likely to occur?

Answer:

- a) In order to finalise the National Framework for Neonatal Hearing Screening, it was necessary to update the accompanying document, National performance indicators to support neonatal hearing screening in Australia, originally prepared by the Australian Institute of Health and Welfare in 2011.
- b) The draft National Framework for Neonatal Hearing Screening and the accompanying Australian Institute of Health and Welfare paper National performance indicators to support neonatal hearing screening in Australia, were endorsed by the Community Care and Population Health Principal Committee in August 2013.
