Question:

Again, could I just ask if you could again give me figures in relation to dementia research, I think 2013-14? You will take that on notice? What about 2012, 2011 and 2010?

Answer:

Over the period from 2000-2013 National Health and Medical Research Council has supported 364 grants totalling over \$205 million in the areas of research in Alzheimer's disease and other dementias. Details of funding for the years 2010-12 are highlighted in Table 1.

A further \$51.7 million is committed until 2017.
