### **Question:**

Just bear with me for a moment. In relation to those cancer centres, Ms Smith, on the website it has: 'Project'; 'Funding (Cwth)'; 'Approximate catchment population'; 'Satellite sites', 'Services to be provided'. Could you take on notice the progress towards those projects? Against the services to be provided? Okay. Can you tell me: are they all progressing as planned?

#### Answer:

In total there are 25 regional cancer centre projects\*. 23 of the 25 projects in the Australia-wide network of regional cancer centre projects are funded under the Health and Hospitals Fund. Of the 25 projects, one is delayed by greater than six months. The details are provided below:
