### Question:

What is the average cost per week for the locum under the program and what does it cover?

#### Answer:

The average cost per week is \$3200.00 for the travel, accommodation and the incentives for the locum. The fixed cost for a weekly placement would be the incentive and meal allowances. Accommodation and travel vary. Accommodation can range from the higher end of \$205 per night in a peak season compared to \$7.41 staying in nurses' quarters. Travel can range from the most expensive being \$6397.10 in an RA5 area in Western Australia to an RA2 area in New South Wales costing \$174.88.
