### **Question:**

- a) In its 2011-12 annual report, the Department notes that the number of general practices receiving incentives for employing practice nurses is below the Department's target? Does more recent data indicate that the shortfall is continuing?
- b) What measures to redress this shortfall have been evaluated?

#### **Answer:**

- a) No, more recent data indicates that the number of practices approved for the Practice Nurse Incentive Program (PNIP) is in line with expectations. For the 2012-13 financial year the target number of practices for PNIP is 4,000. The most recent data available for PNIP, May 2013 indicates that there are 3,978 practices approved for PNIP.
