Can you provide a break down, under the transitional agreement, between the funding committed by the Commonwealth and the funding committed by the states and territories for each jurisdiction?

Answer:

The following table provides a breakdown of expected funding under the transitional Agreement for 2013-14.

Service delivery funding amounts are drawn from draft Implementation Plans, which are yet to be agreed between Commonwealth and State Ministers with responsibility for homelessness. States are required to at least match the Commonwealth contribution for service delivery.

Development Fund amounts reflect funding offers made to jurisdictions. Jurisdictions are required to confirm acceptance of the offer and at least match the Commonwealth contribution.
