Senator Furner asked:

In relation to Paid Parental Leave, has the Department done any analysis of location - for example, LGAs - with the highest concentrations of women earning over \$100,000? If so what does this analysis show?

Answer:

The Department has undertaken some limited analysis of income by location, based on 2011 Census data.

The overall pattern shows that metropolitan areas have higher proportions of women earning over \$100,000 than other areas (for example, regional, rural and remote areas).
