Senator Payne asked:

In May 2009, states and territories agreed on a target of transferring up to 75 per cent of the housing stock funded under the Social Housing Initiative to the community housing sector within the following five years. Can the department provide an update on progress towards that goal? Of Social Housing Initiative housing stock that has been transferred, how much has been transferred with title, and how much has been transferred for the purposes of tenancy management alone?

Answer:

In May 2009, Housing Ministers agreed that States and Territories would transfer up to 75 per cent of the dwellings built under stage 2 of the Social Housing Initiative (SHI) to the community housing sector by 2014.

In June 2013, the Department of Families, Housing, Community Services and Indigenous Affairs requested information from the states and territories on progress with the transfer of properties. The following information was received:

This indicates that to date, 79 per cent of all dwellings (Stage 1 and 2) to be constructed under the SHI have already been transferred to the community housing sector including 45 per cent title transfer* and 35 per cent where tenancy management alone was transferred. Jurisdictions have therefore already exceeded the transfer target.
