## Question:

a) How much did each department/agency spend on taxis from Additional Estimates in February 2014 to date? Provide a breakdown for each business group in each department/agency.
b) What are the reasons for taxi costs?

## Answer:

a) The department spent a total of \$499,380 of expenditure on taxi travel from 1 March 2014 to 31 May 2014. The breakdown by business group is given below:

b) Taxi services are used for official business purposes where it is more economical and efficient than maintaining a large fleet of vehicles. Taxis are often the only form of transport available where car hire or public transport is not an option (for example, in rural and remote communities or during natural disaster recovery work) or to provide transport to assist job seekers to find employment.
