#### Senator Whish-Wilson asked:

Can the Department provide the number of students who receive Youth Allowance/Austudy) scholarships by Federal electorate and level of study? (If electorate data is unavailable please provide by state and territory)

#### **Answer:**

Preparing Youth Allowance and Austudy scholarship data at the electorate and study level would require a significant diversion of departmental resources from other business priorities and regular operations. Table 1 below lists the number of students (unique count) who received at least one Student Start-up Scholarship payment, by state and territory and payment type, in the 2013 calendar year.
