Question:

In addition to the co-payments for out of hospital Medicare services, the Budget includes significant changes to existing MBS arrangements (frozen rebates and Medicate Levy and Private Health Insurance income thresholds) and Medicare Safety Nets. Together these will have an impact on affordability as costs increase, people pay a higher levy as their income is pushed into higher income tiers, and consumers take longer to reach safety net thresholds. Compensatory mechanisms are being eroded at the same time as out of pocket expenses are increasing. Has the government done any modelling to assess the real impact of all the changes on people's ability to access services?

Answer:

No modelling was undertaken on this issue as it is not standard practice to estimate second round effects.
