

Food packaging industry survey

Dear food packaging industry members

As you are aware, food packaging is important for protecting food from contamination, it also helps keep food fresh and provides information too. However, chemicals can also migrate from food packaging. This has the potential to present risks to human health and safety if not effectively managed.

Standard 1.4.3 of the Australia New Zealand Food Standards Code requires that articles and materials in contact with food are safe. The Standard does not specify materials that can be used in the manufacture of food packaging materials or the method of manufacture. The responsibility rests with manufacturers and retailers to ensure that their products are safe and comply with all relevant legislation.

For plastic materials, the Standard refers to the Australian Standard for Plastic Materials for Food Contact Use, AS 2070-1999. This Standard provides a guide to industry about the production of plastic materials for food contact use. AS 2070, in turn, refers to the regulations of the United States and the European Union. Additionally, Standard 1.4.1 – Contaminants and Natural Toxicants, includes a number of maximum levels (MLs) for chemicals associated with migration from packaging, including vinyl chloride and acrylonitrile.

The purpose of this questionnaire is to gather information on materials and articles used in food packaging in Australia and New Zealand and associated quality assurance and control processes. This information will assist Food Standards Australia New Zealand (FSANZ) in understanding the processes manufacturers and the food industry use to ensure the safety of food packaging and food in Australia and New Zealand. FSANZ is also hoping to gather information on the future of food packaging, including the use of new technologies (eg. nanotechnology).

The information collected in this questionnaire will assist FSANZ in ensuring current regulatory processes are adequate and protect public health and safety. A summary of the overall results of the questionnaire will be provided to companies that participate in the questionnaire.
