### **Question:**

Has any analysis been done, or being planned, to determine/track the impact of the GP co-payment on people with mental health issues?

#### Answer:

It is not possible to identify in Medicare data whether a person has a mental health issue.

However, there are some specific items associated with mental health assessment, management and treatment, such as visits to a psychiatrist or a psychologist and GP mental health items, for example for a GP consultation to prepare or review a mental health care plan. These Medicare Benefits Schedule items are not included in the patient contribution measure.
