At hearing, Mr Withnell suggested that there had been 29 matters referred to the CDPP in 2013-14. Please provide a breakdown of the offences (e.g. Section XYZ of 'Assessment Act') to which those 29 referrals was attributed?

### Answer:

The breakdown of offences for the 29 referrals to the CDPP in the 2013-14 financial year are detailed in the table below.
