### **Question:**

How much does the Department recover by way of costs awarded in favour of the Child Support Registrar from enforcement orders?

### Answer:

In making an application for enforcement, the Department will seek an enforcement order as well as an order from the Court that the respondent will pay a portion of the legal costs it has incurred.

Since the inception of the Child Support Scheme in 1988, a total of \$9.7 million in costs and fines has been raised. Of those, \$7.6 million has been recovered.
