#### **Question:**

What is the cost of the additional resources that have been spent on reconciling and correcting inaccurate means testing and income testing letters for aged care residents and home care package clients since 1 July 2014?

#### **Answer:**

The department does not collect specific data that would identify the resources that have been applied to inaccurate means testing and income testing letters for aged care since 1 July 2014. Between July 2014 and September 2014, approximately 20 per cent of means testing letters required manual intervention. As at June 2015, this is now less than 1.5 per cent.
