| 30 May 2015: | <i>New addition</i> of the terms of reference for the review of the implementation of the national reform agenda on organ and tissue donation and transplantation.   |
| 1 June 2015: | <i>New addition</i> of the report on the evaluation of the Supporting Leave for Living Organ Donors Programme pilot.   |
