**Senator Lines, Sue asked:**

How many families will increase their hours and how many are expected to take up new jobs? If you could do that by geographical area, including state, region and electorate. And the participation impact, in terms of increased hours and jobs, for single and dual families, because presumably you went after single and dual families.

**Answer:**

It is estimated that 240,000 families will be encouraged to increase their involvement in paid employment because of the new child care measures.
