Senator Moore, Claire asked:

What is the aim of the Integrated Carer Plan and:

- a) how will you ensure that it takes into account carers diverse range of circumstances and needs?
- b) who will be on the Integrated Carer Plan's Advisory Group?
- c) what measures were taken to ensure that the Advisory Group could adequately represent the diversity of needs for Carers, including young carers?
- d) how often will the Integrated Carer Plan's Advisory Board meet?

Answer:

The Integrated Plan for Carer Support Services (Plan) will outline the future carer support service model, including the design and transition of services from the current system, to a fully integrated system.

- a) The Department has commissioned research on the information and support needs of carers and it will use this research to inform the development of the Plan. The Carer Gateway Advisory Group will also provide advice on carer needs.
