**Senator Moore, Claire asked:**

In terms of your arrangements in the Department, how many Commonwealth cars or cars that have the right to car parking do you have to provide?

**Answer:**

The Department provides car parking for Senior Executive Service (SES) Officers as part of their employment conditions. As at 31 March 2015, 112 SES were employed by the Department nationally.

The Department has 85 leased/pool vehicles nationally that require car parking facilities; this includes seven vehicles provided to the SES under the Executive Vehicle Scheme.

The vehicles are located in the following areas:

In total, 120 secure basement car parking spaces are to be provided in the new Tuggeranong building for SES, leased/pool vehicles, disabled and visitor parking.
