## **Question:**

ANSES did not try and analyse why this previously unidentified effect occurred, but would FSANZ agree that this could be associated with the titanium dioxide having a larger nanoscale particle component? (a) If no, on what basis do you discount this possibility?

#### **Answer:**

No.

(a) The 2017 French study was a preliminary study with limitations as acknowledged by ANSES. The experiment to demonstrate that the nanoparticle fraction of E171 is responsible for the observed preneoclastic lesion formation was not conducted. Therefore, no conclusion can be made that the observed effects are associated with a larger nano-scale particle component.
