Question:

Why are the operations of the AIS being looked at in a separate 'National Institute Review' but not, according to Dr Studdert, anticipated to be part of the National Sports Plan consultations?

Answer:

The 'National Institute Review' is a joint Commonwealth, State and Territory Government and sports project initiated by resolution of the Meeting of Sport and Recreation Ministers. It had commenced prior to the decision to develop a National Sports Plan and is being undertaken in parallel.

Information collected during the Review process as well as any outcomes, should timings align, will be considered as part of the National Sports Plan.
