Question:

a) Has the Department conducted an overall evaluation of the efficacy of existing health services in addressing Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander ear disease? If not, why not?

b) The Royal Australasian College of Surgeons is advocating for a national approach to address this issue as a matter of urgency. Has the Department conducted any modelling on a national approach to ear health?

Answer:

- a) An independent examination of the effectiveness of Australian Government funded ear health activities is underway. Findings will be available in the second half of 2017.
- b) The Australian Government is currently working with State and Territory Governments through the Australian Health Ministers' Advisory Council to consider whether there is a need for a national framework to tackle ear disease in Indigenous children.
