Notes:

The above table provides service volumes for all after-hours attendances. This includes after-hours attendances provided:

- At consulting rooms MBS items 5000, 5020, 5040, 5060, 5200, 5203, 5207, 5208;
- Within a residential aged care facility (RACF) MBS items: 5010, 5028, 5049, 5067, 5260, 5263, 5267:
- A place other than a consulting room or RACF (eg home visit) MBS items: 5003, 5023, 5043, 5063, 5220, 5223, 5227, 5228; and
- Urgent after-hours attendances MBS items: 597, 598, 599, 600.
- b) Data provided above shows that approximately 18% of after-hours attendances are provided to children under 10-years of age. About 18% of services are provided to women between the age of 20 and 39-years, and 21% of after-hours attendances are provided to people over the age of 60-years.

For urgent after-hours attendances only approximately 30% of urgent after-hours attendances are provided to children under 10-years of age. About 15% of services are provided to women between the age of 20 and 39-years, and 23% of urgent after-hours attendances are provided to people over the age of 60-years. Figures based on 2015-16 date of processing data.

MBS data does not capture information on whether a service was provided to a person in a residential aged care facility, unless the items are specifically for residents of aged care facilities. There are specific items for non-urgent after-hours attendances for residents of an aged care facility – in 2015-16 there were 579,262 after-hours visits to residential aged care facility, based on date of processing data.

MBS data does not capture information on whether services are provided to parents or carers.
