Senator Siewart asked:

What is being done to ensure funding and resources are given to the Katungal Aboriginal Corporation Community Medical Health Services to maintain and enhance Aboriginal health services in Bega and throughout the region?

Answer:

The Katungal Aboriginal Corporation Community Medical Health Service receives ongoing funding from the Department to maintain and enhance health services for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples in Bega and throughout the region.

Funding to the Katungal Aboriginal Corporation Community Medical Health Service has increased by around 7% in total over the last four years. The total amount provided to the organisation over this period has amounted to \$6.3 million.
