Written Question on Notice

Senator Siewert asked:

Which were the five most frequently visited destinations for which travel allowance was paid and how much money was spent on travel allowance?

Answer:

In 2009-10 the five most frequently visited destinations by the Office for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Health (OATSIH) staff (including officers in the State and Territory offices) were: Canberra, Darwin, Melbourne, Alice Springs and Brisbane. The total amount of travel allowance paid in relation to these trips was \$104,023.
