Senator Adams asked:

Do you have the numbers of Indigenous medical students, nursing students and allied health students that are actually training at the moment?

Answer:

Whilst the Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations (DEEWR) keeps some data it is difficult to compile and accurately maintain due to difficulties monitoring Indigenous students, and students choosing not to identify. In addition, privacy issues are a concern given the indicative small numbers of students involved in some disciplines.

DEEWR have provided 2008 university Indigenous student enrolment data (which is the latest data available), as follows:
