Now that you look back, what is the total cost of the whole pandemic, if I could put it under that umbrella, rather than separate from the usual seasonal flu?

Answer:

The Department of Health and Ageing's (DoHA) expenditure for the pandemic (H1N1) influenza 2009 response totalled \$204.297 million (GST exclusive). This was funded by redirecting existing resources and through new money provided in the 2009-10 Budget.
