Written Question on Notice

Senator Fierravanti-Wells asked:

- a) What are the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. special type of paper, envelopes)?
- b) What are the cost of these items?
- c) Is the department/portfolio agencies paying for these?

Answer:

- a) The specialist stationery provided to the offices of the Health and Ageing Portfolio Ministers and Parliamentary Secretary is generally Triotec Unique A4, Triotec Unique A3 and Triotec Recycled A4 paper.
- b) For the calendar year 1 November 2009 to 31 October 2010 the cost of these items for Ministers' offices and the Parliamentary Secretary in the Health and Ageing Portfolio was \$4,392.79 (GST exclusive).
- c) The department pays for these supplies.
