- b) Is funding being provided to the Western Australia outside of the COAG agreement arrangements? Is so, has this commenced yet and how is the funding being provided?
- c) Is it the case that the government cannot proceed without agreement of the West Australian Government?
- d) If so, where then does this leave the Rudd/Gillard health reforms?
- e) Does the Federal government intend to penalise Western Australia which already receives far less of the GST carve up than any other states?
- f) Will all funds flow to Western Australia as they will to other states?
